

5 Essential Bible Study Questions

A simple framework for meaningful group discussions

1

What stands out to you in this passage?

This open-ended question helps people share their initial reactions without feeling pressured to have the "right" answer.

Examples:

- A word or phrase that seems important
- Something that surprised them
- A verse that felt encouraging or challenging

2

What questions do you have about this passage?

Normalizing questions creates a safe learning environment and often leads to the richest discussions.

Examples:

- Why did this character act this way?
- What does this word/phrase mean?
- How does this connect to other Bible stories?

3

What do we learn about God from this passage?

Helps focus on God's character and nature, which is central to all Bible study.

Examples:

- God's faithfulness, love, or justice
- How God interacts with people
- God's promises or commands

4

How might this apply to our lives today?

Bridges the gap between ancient text and modern life, making Scripture personally relevant.

Examples:

- How we treat others
- Trusting God in difficult circumstances
- Making decisions based on biblical principles

5

What is one thing you want to remember from our discussion?

Helps people identify their key takeaway and prepares them to live differently because of what they've learned.

Examples:

- A specific verse or promise
- An insight about God's character
- A practical way to apply the passage
